Roger and David Otwell were one of the most popular singing groups to ever perform on **Lawrence Welk**, taping some 300 shows which aired to over fifty million viewers each week. Originally from Tulia, Texas, this highly sought after duo also performed across the United States at various state fairs, prestigious theaters, **Disney World**, **Disney Land** and **Madison Square Gardens**. They guest starred numerous times on **Nashville Now**, appeared on **Dinah Shore**, **ABC'S 20/20**, and were featured in a **PBS documentary**. Their music video, **One Nation Under God**, climbed to number three on the country music charts. Throughout their performance career, the Otwells have shared the stage with such artists as **Chuck Berry**, **Barbara Mandrell**, **Marty Robins**, **The Hager Twins** and many more. Besides owning their own businesses, the Otwells are professional songwriters who produced and starred in the Branson-style show, **Can't Get Enough of Texas** with **Tim Lewis**. As co-founders of **Old Tascosa Publishing**, they play an integral part in the music industry and continue to make appearances on the **Lawrence Welk** reunion shows.

Tim Lewis is a published playwright and author, having penned over twenty plays & musicals and three novels. He is also a professional speaker, cowboy poet, actor and songwriter. An avid writer of the cowboy culture, Tim is author of the Branson-style musical revue, **Can't Get Enough Of Texas**, which starred the **Otwell Twins** of **Lawrence Welk** fame. Mr. Lewis received formal training at Sam Houston State University, where he earned a bachelor's degree in Music Education with a vocal emphasis. He is also a graduate of The Institute Of Children's Literature. Post graduate studies include playwriting & directing at the University of Texas and history of the southwest at West Texas A&M. His article, *Freighting on the XIT Ranch of Texas*, was published in the *Panhandle-Plains Historical Review*. Tim's performance credits are many, including: **Standin' in the Stirrups**, **The Old Maid and the Thief**, **The King and I**, **The Music Man**, **Death of a Salesman**, **Can't Get Enough Of Texas** and **Texas Legacies**. Currently, Mr. Lewis teaches a basic novel writing class as part of the Continuing Education curriculum at West Texas A&M University and is a co-founder of Old Tascosa Publishing.
